




## Why fix draughts?


#### Main benefits

- ✓ Comfort
  - Warmer in winter, cooler in summer
- ✓ Saves money
  - Lower heating and cooling bills
- Health
  - Prevent smoke, dust, pollen, insects, etc. coming into your home

#### Added benefits

- Quieter
  - No more rattling doors and windows
  - Reduced traffic noise
- ✓ Increase your home's value
  - Improved energy rating
- Helps the environment
  - Reduced carbon emissions

## How to find draughts



Obvious gaps

Light around doors and windows

Moving curtains, spider webs

Or ask a professional!



#### LISTEN for:

Rattling and whistling



#### FEEL for:

Cold or moving air

#### How to prevent draughts

- Seal gaps, cracks and wall vents
- Install seals on bottoms of doors
- Install perimeter seals around doors and windows
- Insulate and seal ceiling hatch covers
- 'Zone out' rooms, e.g. bathroom and laundry

#### Make it good quality!

Stick on weather stripping hardly ever works. The cheap stuff will degrade and fall off in no time.

In fact, stick on weather stripping can prevent doors and windows from closing properly, which will make your draughts worse!

#### Metal windows

Mould likes to grow around and on metal (aluminium and steel) window frames

- Seal up gaps around the frame
- Keep the architraves and frames clean
- Wipe down any window condensation
- Ventilate during the day (winter) or at night (summer)



How you can seal up perimeters of doors (top and sides)



## Sealing under the door

Brush (sweep) seal can seal bottom gaps and sweep smoothly over floorboards, tile etc.



#### Windows

- Double hung
- Awning
- Casement
- Shugg (frameless)
- Aluminium sliding
- Steel awning or casement



## Sealing up gaps, cracks and wall vents

Don't use cheap gap filler!





